

Access to ENT Care is AT RISK



A proposed Medicare change could make it harder to get timely ear, nose and throat care. Starting in 2027, Medicare will pay less when a doctor provides more than one needed service during the same visit. This could make it harder for patients to get the care they need in one appointment.

WHAT THIS MEANS

YOU MAY FACE:

- ⚠ Fewer physicians accepting Medicare
- ⚠ More visits for care
- ⚠ Longer waits for appointments
- ⚠ Less access to needed services
- ⚠ Fewer choices as practices consolidate or close

YOUR VOICE MATTERS



CALL CONGRESS: 202-224-3121

Ask your senators and congressional representative to protect access to care. Urge them to support fair payment for needed services provided on the same day.

A simple message: "I'm a Medicare patient and your constituent. Please fully value needed same-day care so patients can get timely, efficient care. The proposed 2027 Medicare policy puts patient access at risk."



COMMENT TO CMS

Ask Medicare to fully value needed same-day care and protect patient access.
